#### **CASTING CROWNS**

#### **Revelation 4**

Even heaven's royalty cast their crowns before the Lord.

#### I. TWENTY-FOUR ELDERS SITTING TWENTY-FOUR THRONES

#### A. Revelation 4:4a

The throne of Christ is surrounded by 24 others on which are seated 24 elders.

#### **B.** Matthew 19:28

Jesus had already told the apostles they would sit 12 thrones in heaven.

## C. Revelation 21:12, 14

So, besides the 12 apostles, the other thrones must be occupied by the 12 patriarchs.

### II. WEARING GOLDEN CROWNS

#### A. Revelation 4:4<sub>b</sub>

The 24 elders are crowned with gold.

### B. 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 9:24-27

Christians are promised imperishable crowns.

# C. 2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 4:7-8

Crowns of righteousness await those who faithfully served Christ.

### D. James 1:12

These are crowns of life which await those who love Him.

# E. 2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 2:11-13

Why crowns? Because we are assured we will reign with Him!

### III. OFFERING WORSHIP

### **A. Revelation 4:9-10**<sub>a</sub>

These crowned and enthroned elders worship along with the four living creatures.

## B. Acts 12:20-24; 10:24-26

Mere men, even kings and apostles, are not worthy of worship.

## C. Matthew 2:11; 8:2; 9:18; 14:33; 15:25; 28:9

Throughout His life, from birth to the resurrection, and in between, Jesus received worship.

## D. Philippians 2:9-11

Someday, every knee will bow to Jesus; even those in heaven will kneel.

#### IV. SURRENDERING THEIR CROWNS

### A. Revelation 4:10<sub>b</sub>

Across the crystal sea, these elders cast down their crowns, knowing their reign is subservient to His.

## B. 1<sup>st</sup> Chronicles 29:10-12; Daniel 4:34-35; 6:25-27

Other kings on earth paid homage to God in His supremacy.

## C. 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy 6:11-16; Revelation 17:14; 19:16

There are other kings, but Jesus is King of kings.

#### D. Luke 17:7-10

No matter how well we serve our Master, He remains Master and we are mere servants. Obedience is real and necessary, but it never means we earn our place in heaven.

### A. 1<sup>st</sup> Peter 2:9-12

The royal priesthood that receives mercy is composed of those who have forsaken darkness for light, full of good works and abstinence from sin.

### B. John 3:3-5
