THE PREACHING & TEACHING OF THE MESSIAH

I. WHEN DID HE PREACH & TEACH?

A. Luke 2:42-47

Although He displayed exceptional spiritual awareness early on, His preaching began later.

B. Luke 3:23

He began preaching when He was 30.

II. WHERE DID HE PREACH & TEACH?

He preached everywhere He could, inside and outside, sitting or standing or walking, in religious venues and in private homes.

A. Matthew 5:1-2

"He went up on a **mountain**, and when He was seated His disciples came to Him. Then He opened His mouth and taught them."

B. Matthew 13:1-3

"Jesus went out of the house and sat by the sea. And great multitudes were gathered together to Him, so that He got into a **boat** and sat; and the whole multitude stood on the shore. Then He spoke many things to them."

C. Matthew 13:54

"He taught them in their synagogue."

D. Luke 21:37

"He was teaching in the temple."

E. Mark 8:27; 10:17

"On the **road** He asked His disciples..." and "As He was going out on the **road**, one came running, knelt before Him, and asked Him..." He both asked and answered questions on the road.

F. Luke 14:15

"One of those who sat at the table with Him heard these things."

Jesus ministered the gospel the way Moses commanded parents in Israel to teach their children: "teach them diligently... when you sit... when you walk... when you lie down... when you rise up" (Deuteronomy 6:7). Paul went on to do likewise, saying he "taught you publicly and from house to house" (Acts 20:20).

III. WHOM DID HE PREACH & TEACH TO?

A. Matthew 15:21-28; John 4:5-10

He preached to a target audience of Jews, but was glad to give attention to exceptional Gentiles.

B. Matthew 22:41-45

He preached to Pharisees, even though they clearly despised Him.

C. Luke 15:1-7

He preached to sinners in need of forgiveness.

IV. How did He Preach & Teach?

A. Matthew 13:34

He preached in parables.

B. Matthew 17:10-12

He answered questions.

C. Matthew 23:27-28; Mark 11:15-17

He corrected error, sometimes forcefully.

D. Luke 4:16-21

He preached textual application.

E. Mark 8:1-2

He preached lengthy messages with crowds following Him days at a time.

F. Luke 13:1-5

He preached in reference to current events.

G. Luke 12:13-14

He taught without involving Himself in petty personal squabbles.

H. Matthew 7:2829

He preached with unmatched authority.

V. WHAT DID JESUS PREACH & TEACH?

A. Matthew 5:2-9

He preached about right attitudes: "Blessed are the meek..." etc.

B. Matthew 10:38

He preached about persecution and suffering: "He who does not take His cross after Me is not worthy of Me."

C. Matthew 5:16

He preached about influence: "Let your light so shine..."

D. Luke 16:16

He preached about the Covenants: "The law and the prophets were until John..."

E. **John 14:15**

He preached obedience: "Keep My commandments."

F. Matthew 5:21-26, 43-48

He preached about anger management and reconciliation: "Whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment."

G. Matthew 5:27-28

He preached about purity of thought: "Whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart."

H. Matthew 5:29-30

He preached about priorities and sacrifice: "If your right eye causes you to sin, pluck it out."

I. Matthew 5:31-32

He preached about marriage and divorce: "whoever marries a woman who is divorced commits adultery."

I. Matthew 5:33-37

He preached about honesty: "Do not swear at all..."

K. Matthew 5:38-42

He preached about humility and submission: "Not to resist an evil person."

L. Acts 20:35

He preached about giving: "It is better to give than to receive."

M. Matthew 6:5-13

He preached about prayer: "When you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites."

N. Matthew 6:14-15

He preached about forgiveness: "If you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses."

O. Matthew 6:16-18

He preached about religious sincerity: "When you fast, do not be like the hypocrites, with a sad countenance. For they disfigure their faces that they may appear to men to be fasting."

P. Matthew 6:19-21

He preached about materialism: "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth."

Q. Matthew 6:22-23

He preached about wholesome viewership: "The lamp of the body is the eye."

R. Matthew 6:24

He preached about loyalty and devotion: "No one can serve two masters."

S. Matthew 6:25-33

He preached about anxiety relief: "Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing?"

T. Matthew 7:1-6

He preached about hypocritical judgment: "With what judgment you judge, you will be judged."

U. Matthew 7:7-11

He preached about spiritual pursuit and progress: "Seek and you will find."

V. Matthew 7:12

He preached about the "golden rule": "Whatever you want men to do you, do also to them."

W. Matthew 7:13-14

He preached about minority salvation: "Enter by the narrow gate."

X. Matthew 7:15-20

He preached about false teachers: "By their fruits you will know them."

Y. Matthew 12:36-37

He preached about pure communication: "By your words you will be justified and by your word you will be condemned."

Z. Matthew 12:48-50

He preached about fellowship: "Whoever does the will of My Father in heaven is My brother."

AA. Matthew 13:1-9, 18-23

He preached about preaching: "A sower went out to sow."

BB. Matthew 15:1-9

He preached about the dangers of tradition: "Why do you transgress the commandment... because of your tradition?"

CC. Matthew 18:1-5

He preached about humility: "Whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven."

DD. Matthew 18:15-20

He preached about church discipline: "If your brother sins against you..."

EE. Matthew 22:15-21

He preached about submission to government: "Render... to Caesar the things that are Caesar's."

FF. Matthew 22:23-33

He preached about resurrection: "God is not the God of the dead, but of the living."

GG. Matthew 13:47-52

He preached about judgment day: "There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth."

HH. John 14:6

He preached about His own uniqueness: "No one comes to the Father except through Me."

II. John 3:18; Matthew 10:32-33; 4:17; 28:19-20

He preached about salvation:

- 1. "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."
- 2. "Whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven."
- **3.** "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."
- 4. "Make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you."
